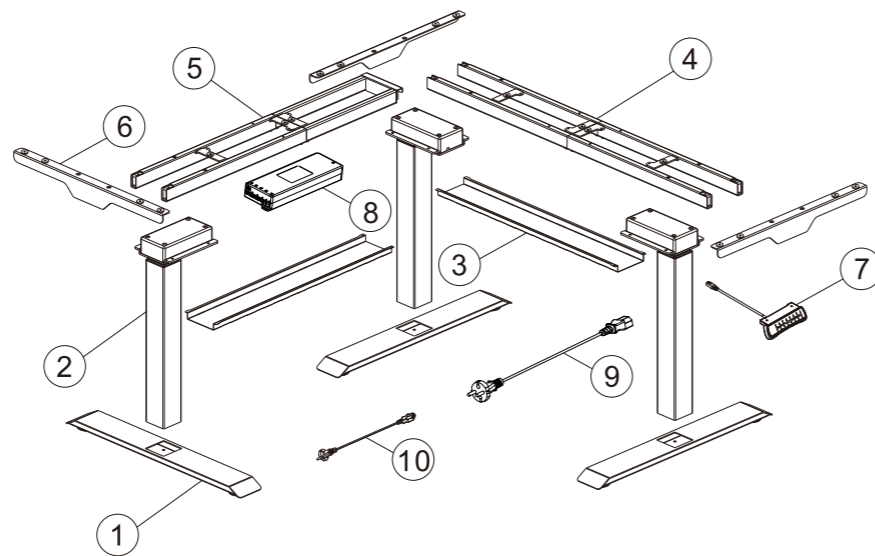

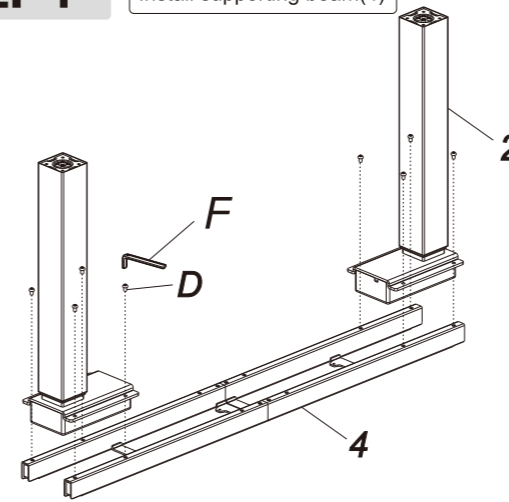

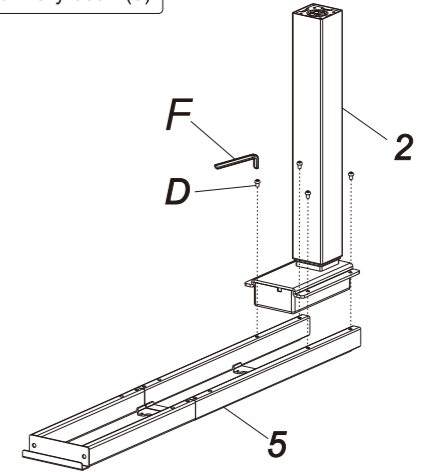
STEP 1

Install lifting column (2) and supporting beam (4) together, use wrench (F) to tighten the screws (D).

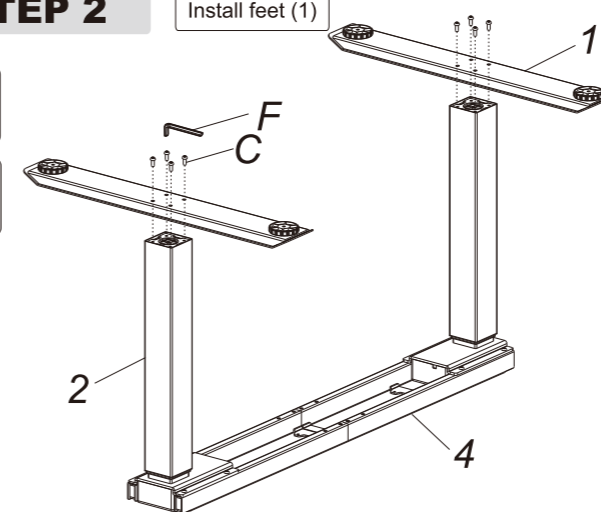
Install auxiliary beam(5)



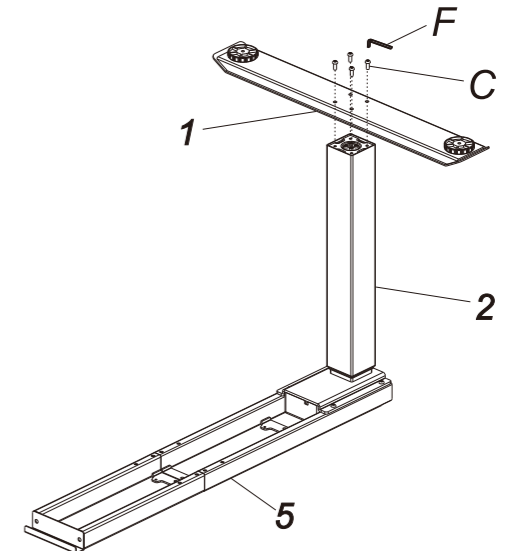
Install lifting column (2) and auxiliary beam (5) together, use wrench (F) to tighten the screws (D).

Install feet (1)

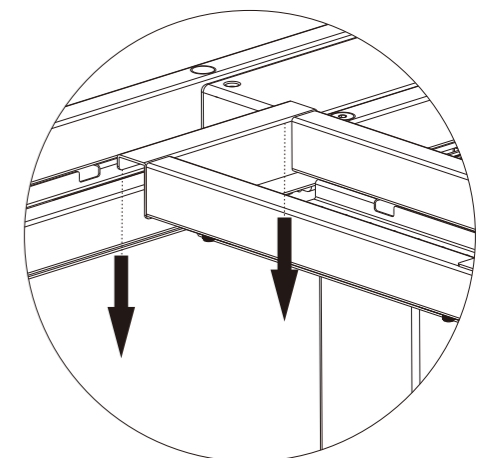
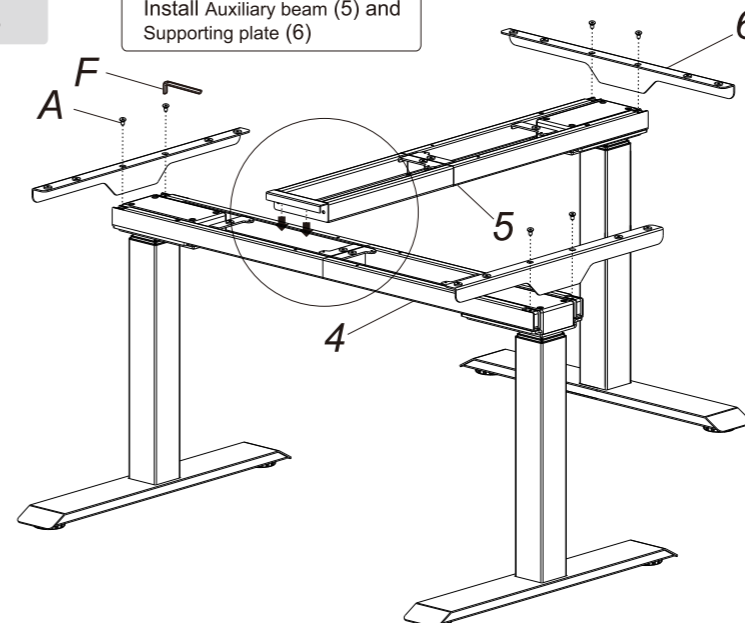


Install feet (1) and lifting column (2) together, use wrench (F) to tighten the screws (C).



STEP 3

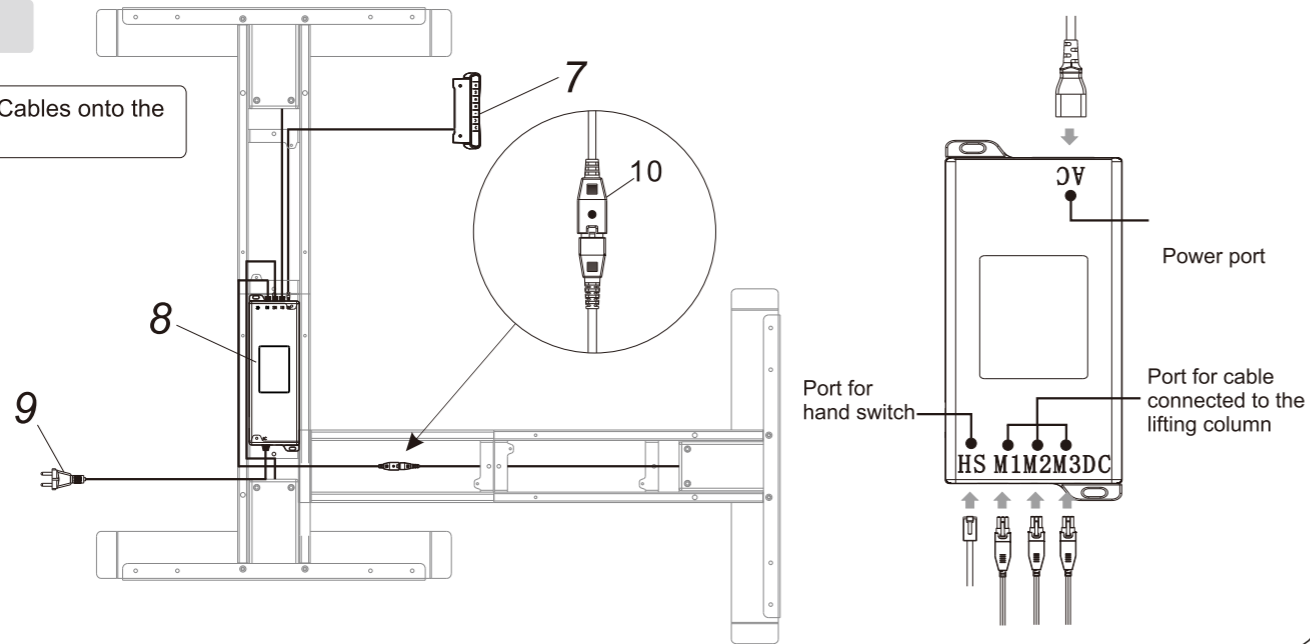
Install Auxiliary beam (5) and Supporting plate (6)



Buckle in the auxiliary beam (5) to the supporting beam (4), and the specific position can be selected according to the tabletop.

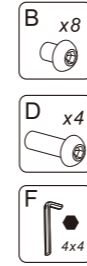
STEP 4

Connect All the Cables onto the Control Box(8)

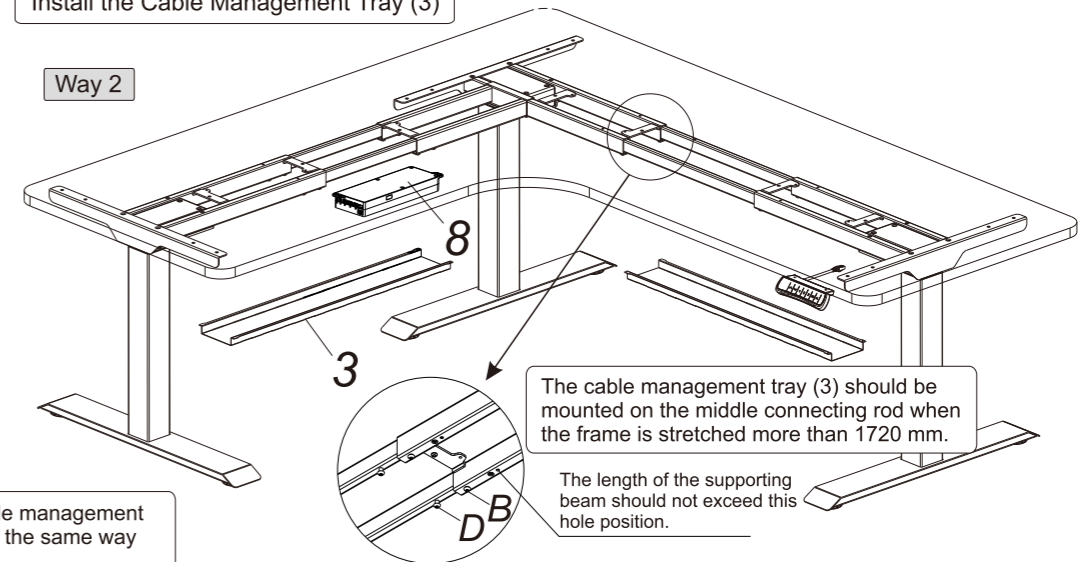


STEP 6-B

Install the Cable Management Tray (3)



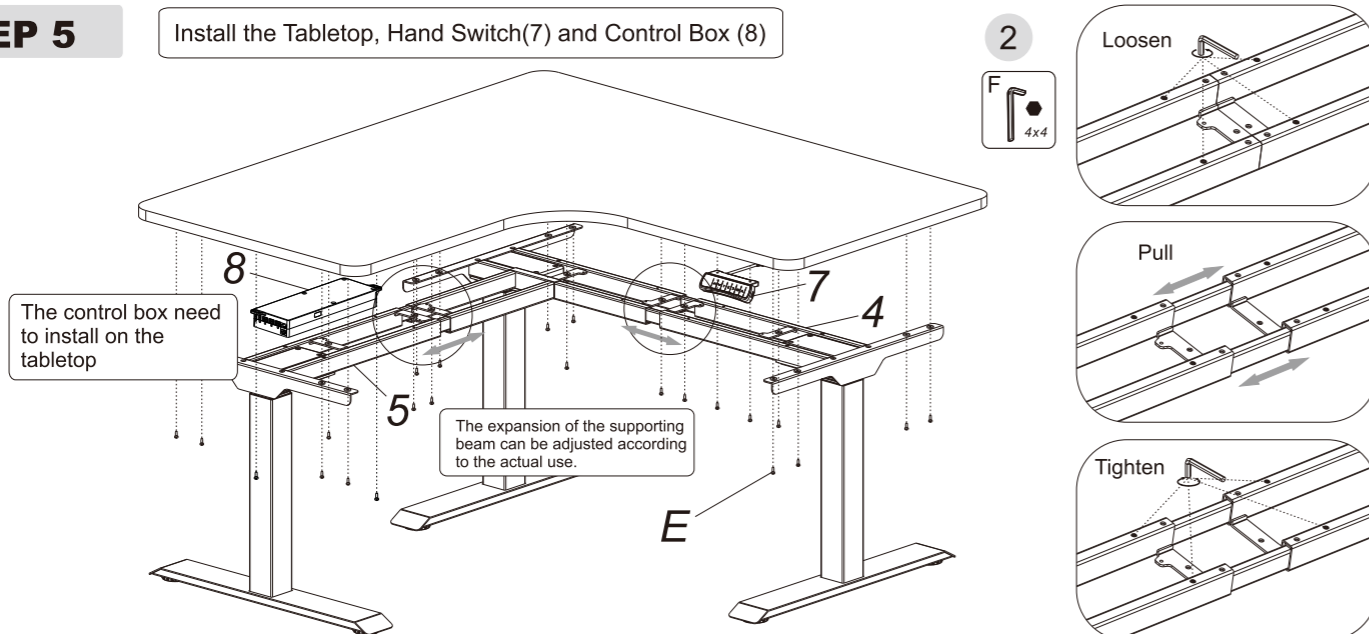

Common fault treatment

The following tips will help you detected and eliminate the common fault and error. If the fault you met is not listed below, please contact with your supplier. Only the manufacturer and professionals are capable for investigating and correcting those fault and error.

Fault phenomenon	Method
No response while long pressing down arrow after connected with a power supply	1. Check if all the cables be connected well 2. Contact your supplier or dealer
No response while pressing up arrow/ down arrow after connected with a power supply	1. Check if all the cables be connected well 2. Contact your supplier or dealer
Rising in a low speed	1. Check if overloaded, max loading: 150kg; 2. Contact your supplier or dealer
The motor not move as instructed	1. Contact your supplier or dealer
Go down but not go up	1. Reposition 2. Contact your supplier or dealer
Downward sliding	1. Check if overloaded, max loading: 150kg; 2. Contact your supplier or dealer
Frequently Reposition	1. Check if overloaded, max loading: 150kg; 2. Contact your supplier or dealer
Overwork (Duty cycle: Max 2min on/18min OFF)	1. Restart after suspend for 18mins while connecting with power; 2. Contact your supplier or dealer;
Not enough up&down height	1. Press "M" and "3" together for 3 seconds or more, after hearing continuous beeping for twice, it will restore factory settings 2. Contact your supplier or dealer

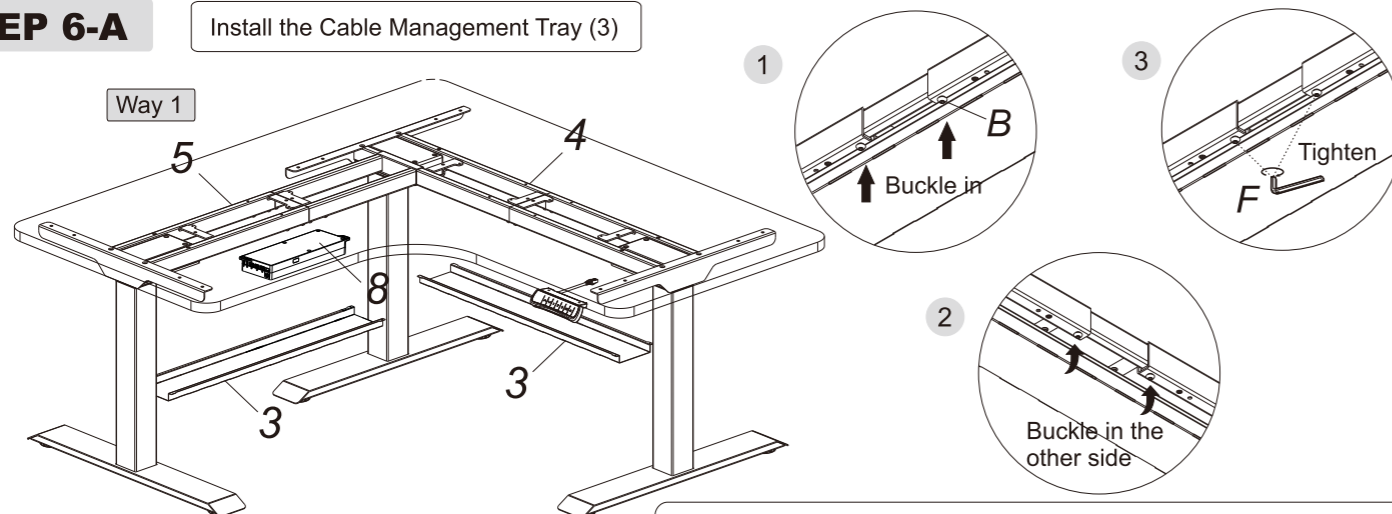
- Power supply: AC100V-240V,50/60Hz
- Service Environment: 0-40°C

STEP 6-A

Install the Cable Management Tray (3)



Way 1



Firstly, screw the screw (B) into the supporting beam (4) with Allen Key (F), and not tighten completely. Buckle one side of the cable management tray (3) into the screw (B), then press the other side into the screw (B). Finally, the screw (B) is locked with Allen Key (F). The cable management tray (3) on the auxiliary beam (5) are installed in the same way.
